Jacob Metz -- born in Germany about 1781 said to be the son of Henry Metz. He emigrated first to Kentucky by way of Hendersontown, Maryland and afterward to the state of Ohio. One of his wives names was Anna Marie Thurman according to the notes of Samuel Lefayet e Sprinkles; this however, is followed by a question mark. He is said to have served briefly in the War of 1812 in the 3rd Reg (Collier's). He died in Ohio Villisita. Checking on this I found this information is on file under the name Metzter. Samuel L. Sprinkle included it in his notes, but I am not satisfied that it was the same person. Jacob died in Adams Co Aug 25, 1862. My grandfather told me that the Metz' escaped from Germany under a hay wagon.

Martha Killian -- married George Killian Nov 25, 1932; she was one of Will Miller's great grandmother.

William Metz -- was married twice and had a total of 14 children: 1st marriage to Katherine Thomas: Sarah A (m William Anderson), Susan (m Joseph McFarland), George (m Amanda Warren), Thomas (m Elizabeth Francis), Margaret Jane (m James McGowney), William J (m Della Gregory) and Samuel. 2nd marriage to Hannah Williams: James C (m Mary DeVoss; he sheriff of Adams Co), David W (father of Pearl Metz McCormick), Jacob F., Lewis T., Edward C., Frank C., Uriah H.

James B Metz, mentioned above under William Metz family, had 5 living children and 3 who died young. Those who lived to maturity: Frank C (m Mrs Anna Bowman Grey), Eddie (m E.A. Scott), Superintendent of schools Augusta, Ky at turn of century), James F., George and Martha. James was born Aug 3, 1846 in Dunbarton, Ohio and served in the Civil War. James moved to Rome and lived there in 1900.

David Sprinkle -- born in Virginia on January 21, 1806 and died in Rome, Ohio May 21, 1876. He is said to be buried in Rome. He married Elisabeth Netz on August 14, 1826 in Adams Co., Ohio. They were married by an R. Wood. They lived in Jacksonville until the moved to Rome sometime after 1860. According to records at the Virginia State Library there were two Sprinkle heads of households in 1810, both in Lytle County. Jacob and Henry Sprinkle. The Jacob Sprinkle household according to the enumeration by sex and age apparently included a married son with children. Odds are good that Jacob, Henry or the unnamed son was David's father.

Elizabeth Metz -- name also spelled Elisabeth, was born April 11, 1811 in either Maryland or Kentucky. Her father was Jacob Netz. "The History of Adams County" says that she was born in Kentucky, but her grandson Samuel Lafayette Sprinkle's notes say that his mother told him Elisabeth was born in Maryland after her father located near Hagerstown. Elisabeth died in Rome on May 28, 1864.

John R Sprinkle -- died prior to his fifth birthday on January 19, 1856.

Martha Ellen Sprinkle Test -- had a daughter named Ethel Test Kennedy who lived

in Cincinnati. She had the Metz Family Bible in the 1940's.

William H Sprinkle -- born in Adams County on May 20, 1834. He was a blacksmith and lived in Jacksonville. He served in the Civil War in Co E., 117 Regt., Ohio Vol. Infantry (later 1st Regt., Ohio Heavy Artillery). His commander was Capt. James Anthony. William enrolled at Portsmouth, Ohio on August 22, 1862 and was discharged June 20, 1865 in Knoxville, Tennessee. He was the company blacksmith and later promoted to artificer. He had blue eyes, brown hair, light complexion, and was 5'10 1/2" according to his military records. His occupation on the records is listed as mechanic. My parents have an anvil of his on their fireplace hearth at their home on Buckeye Lake, Ohio. William died on Dec 6, 1928 and is buried in the cemetery just outside of Jacksonville.

Harriet Mathias -- born July 22, 1839 in Winchester, Ohio, the daughter of Levina Sprinkle and James Mathias. Harriet and William were married by the Rev. Jesse Wm. Wesley on Sept 20, 1855 in Dunbarton, Ohio. She died of a cerebral hemorrhage on Dec 16, 1924. Also buried outside of Jacksonville.

William LeRoy Sprinkle -- born and died in 1870, buried in Jacksonville Cemetery

William Dawson Sprinkle -- born and died in 1870, "

According to Madeline Sprinkle Kilgore there were 10 children rather than 9 in this family. She adds a Charles E b & d 1870; she has William Dawson's dates as 1863; and does not have William Leroy. My grandfather's notes included ~~three~~ Harry and only one William. Have no other knowledge about this Harry. The 7 children who lived to maturity names come from William's pension papers, the information in his own handwriting. I saw the other two (um Leroy and William Dawson) graves in the cemetery in 1969; it said they were sons of Harriet and William Sprinkle and gave the dates I have on the chart.

James Asbury Sprinkle — born July 28, 1856 in Lumberton, Adams Co., Ohio. He attended the district schools and the National Normal University in Lebanon, Ohio, which is no longer in existence. He was a teacher and a Farmer.

Emma Nora Thomas — Nora, as she was called, was born in 1867, the daughter of Samuel N. and Sarah McCoy Thomas. She and Asbury were married August 5, 1885. Nora died in 1923 and she and Asbury are buried in the cemetery outside of Jacksonville.
