




EXPLANATION

Standard No. 1 can be used by schools which have never used a credit system of marking, higher standards being adopted later. In well graded schools No. 1 is fine for beginners and primaries, No. 2 better for juniors and intermediates, and No. 2 for seniors and adults. Some schools prefer "Church Attendance" or "Hand Work" to "Home Study." Very well, make the change or any other desired. It will not hurt the system in the least.

The perfect mark "100" is the schools' ideal for teacher, class and pupil.

FIRST—THE EASY, SIMPLE GOOD OLD WAY.

If the credit method of marking does not suit your needs, the book is just as good as it always has been for marking "P" for presence and "A" for absence.

SECOND-THE EASY, SIMPLE, FAR BETTER NEW WAY

The old way was to mark "P" for present and "A" for absent, and too many schools do it that way still. But the new method is a vast improvement because it encourages and secures regularity, punctuality, liberality, class loyalty, class co-operation and class advancement, and no class, no school is a good one wherein these VITAL THINGS are ignored. The directions for marking are made perfectly plain by the accompanying Illustration showing one Sunday's complete record and also record of teacher and two pupils for three months. By securing the "100" mark every Sunday for three months the Teacher's total was "1,300" who well earned the honor of a place on the "Honor Roll" as indicated by "H.R." Perry Nye seems to have been very careless. He only got 790 credits in all, an average of 60. He can not be praised, but he should be shown his bad record and encouraged to do better next quarter. Perhaps his mother is to blame. She should be seen and the record shown to her and a promise of her help secured. Hugh White did splendidly. If he had not been tardy Feb. 28th and lost 20 by it he too would have gotten on the Honor Roll. Imagine a whole class of 10 getting "100", every one of them, every Sunday for three months. Would it not be the happiest, most helpful class in the school? Would not its example be fine to all classes? Can the reader's class do it?

The Summary of Class Record Shown in Back of Book

Those two pages may be used in full or in part as each school may elect. It will take some extra work, but work which PAYS WELL SHOULD NEVER BE SHIRKED. When used it will reveal the weak as well as the strong points in the class. It will show which classes have earned commendation and congratulation, also those who need kindly advice and encouragement to try for a better record the next quarter. TRY THIS SYSTEM. If you like the looks of it here, you will LOVE the RESULTS of it after three months FAIR TRIAL.
