"PAPABLE OF THE GEESE"

Here in Texas the huge formations of wild geese are one of true signs that autumn is approaching. Have you ever wondered why the Canadian geese fly only in the V formation? For years specialists

in aerodynamics wondered the same thing.

Recently two engineers calibrated in a wind tunnel about what happens in flight to the formation of geese. They soon discovered that each goose in flapping its wings, created an upward lift for the goose that followed! This gave the whole flock 71% greater flying range than if each bird flew alone. When a goose falls back then they immediately feel the heavier load of flying alone, and they speed up to get back into the wind formation. There is no such thing as a Jonathan Livingston Goose! Each depends upon the other to reach their ultimate destination. When a goose continues to lag behind he is encouraged by the flock to get back in and do his share of flapping! All that honking that geese do means "get back where you belong, you are needed by the whole flock in the V formation."
