4. BE STATED CLOSE TO THE FRONT OF THE AUDITORIUM: Leave the back seats for those who arrive late and mothers with small children.


5. BN REVERENT: The meeting house is not a theatre or place of amusment. You have come to worship God. Do it with reverence.



JFSUS WEPT

There are many circumstances in life that occasion tears. Some tears flow in the crucible of personal affliction; there are tears shed in deep and bitter anguish; there are tears that are produced by cruelty and mockery. It is very interesting, however, to read in the scripture that the tears of Jesus were not so occasioned. The Lord suffered in all the ways described above, but we never read that he wept. He was laughed to scorn - his sensitive heart was rent asunder - but the scriptures do not say that he wept. He was spat upon and scourged before his crucifiction, but we do read in this place that he wept. In the garden of Gethsemane we read that the anguish was so deep and intense THAT GREAT DROPS FELL FROM HIS FACE, but we are not told that he wept.

Jesus' tears were not wrung out by his own suffering, but rather by his divine and sincere compassion for others. Only twice, so far as I know, do we read of the tears of Jesus. Once when his friends wept because of the death of a dear one and once because of the insensitivity of his people to their spiritual needs.

It is wonderful to know that we have such a Savior and friend who weeps for our anguish, and hurt and insensitivity. It is a motivation to help us live just a little better. Yes, Jesus wept:not for himself, but for me.
