



EVANGELISM

"Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and the Woly Spirit." "Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you' and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world." Matthew 28:19-20.

The church of our Lord cannot remain evangelical in faith unless it remains evangelistic! Nor can it remain evangelistic unless it is DO-ING evangelism! It seems to me that in order for our faith to be strong and our worship to God to be acceptable, then we must have as our goal the salvation of lost souls. The New Testament church must have in mind and in action one purpose, that is to seek and save the lost and then educate them in obedience of the faith that they have accepted. All other things must be secondary.

One of the mistakes that we make today is that we think we can organize ourselves into an evangelistic church. Nothing but evangelism in action will or can, create an evangelistic church. Jesus gave us a good way to follow; "Ask, and it will be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you;" It is Go! Go! - Teach! Teach! - Seek! Seek! It is Knock! Knock! - Call! Call! until we find the ones

who will accept the Gospel of Christ.

Another mistake churches make, and it may be the largest, is thinking that keeping house for the Lord is working for Him. We secure a song leader, have someone to lead prayer, use several men to serve the Lord's Supper and we leave thinking how pleased the Lord is with our work in His vineyard. There is a great difference between our worship to God and our labor or service to God. Both are essential for us to

please Him.

Another sad mistake that is often made is the idea that evangelism is for a select few. Others seem to think it is optional; that is, these who want to, may, but if you don't want to, don't. This is not so! Every Christian must evangelize! We need to believe and practice Matthew 18:19-20; Mark 16: 15; John 15:1-8; Romans 7:4 just as much as we do Hebrews 10:25. One may as well resolve that you can be a Christian and be saved without attending services, not partaking of the communion, or giving, praying and singing as to think one can be saved and be a Christian without evangelizing. We are saving to serve and save others.

Any time the evangelistic work of the church is given second place or left out, Christ cannot be pleased. Listen to the Bible speak:

"TOMMOROW"







LAST YEAR'S SOUL WINNING WORKSHOP taken from Southside's (sponsering congregation) bulletin

... With the efforts of the area congregations, I am positive that our greatest efforts with visible results in evangelism came from the Soul Winning Workshop last April. Many members from this area worked very hard... and possibly the least amount of visible results was right here in Fort Wayne... Look at some of the results:

Anderson, Indiana, Hillcrest congregation had about five members at the Workshop and they were really motivated to the point that they went home and had 60 baptisms the remainder of the year. They set their goal for 1978 at 100 baptisms. They have already had 67 and have raised their goal to 200 and have a goal of 365 for next year; they have gone out and purchased ten acres and already in a new building program for they have outgrown their present plant. Their contribution budget is \$2600.00 per Sunday and they are making it. They have already reserved rooms in a hotel for 35 persons for the upcoming Workshop and say they will have more. Also they plan to run a schuttle bus daily for those who are able to come only during the day. The elders there have told us that it is the results of the Fort Wayne Workshop that did it.

The Columbus St. congregation in Anderson have already similar records but with less numbers and they are already purchasing property around their building for expansion. They also will tell you that it started with the the Workshop in Ft. Wayne. Similar results from the five state area of Ind., Ohio, Illinois, Michigan and Iowa could be given.

It is impossible to place a value in terms of dollars, on the saving of souls, especially when the Lord compared one soul to more than the whole world Mark Simmons, elder, Southside congreg.
