





We have read in 1 Timothy 2:9 that the apostle Paul wrote that womwn are to "dress modestly, with decency and propriety." (NIV)

How is a Christian teenager to dress in the summer? A guide for the men would be to try to imagine what Christ would wear if He were on the earth today. How does what you wear affect girls who may be around you? Girls are just as likely to lust as boys are. Do you think Christ would run around in public with no shirt? Would he wear tight gym shorts or cut-offs?

What should Christian women wear in the heat of summer? If Christ were alive today and married, what would he let his wife wear? Would He allow her to wear a bikini, tight short shorts, a halter top, tube top, or see-through blouse? Would He permit her to go around braless in order to keep cool?

When we became Christians, Christ's disciples, we made a promise to Christ to follow Him. In points where there is no exact example of behavior spelled out in the Bible, we must do what we feel Christ would do, knowing his attitude. He is not the "Father of the faithful" as his father Abraham. He is not the exciting "Supplanter" his son Jacob was. He never did anything spect-acular, yet the Bible refers to our God as the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Abraham was a giant — we can understand the "God of Abraham." Jacob had qualities from which heroes are made — it is wasy to understand the "God of Jacob." But the "God of Isaac?" What di Isaac ever do? He was born, got married, tended his flock, dug wells and died. Not very interesting? Yet here he is right along beside Abraham and Jacob as one of God's great men.

And herein is the great truth. How many of us are "Abrahams?" How many of us are "Jacobs?" Most of us are "Isaacs." What did Isaac do? Actually he did just what God wanted him to do. He was an obedient son, a faithful husband, a good provider. No scandal is associated with his name. He was a good man from cradle to the grave. God needed Isaac just as the church today could not do without its Isaacs.

We have some "Abrahams" and some "Jacobs" in the church, thank God for our Isaacs. They will never do anything spectacular, but when the preacher stands to preach, there they are in their place and giving their support. When the preacher stands up to teachy there they are. The greatest mistake in life is to do mothing. Isaac did what he could and his name will be forever immortalized in the words: "I am the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." Our God loves the Isaacs as well as the Abrahams and Jacobs. However, it is a mistake to be an Isaac when we could be an Abraham or a Jacob. —Sel.
