As one observes from the concordance, the word thanks and giving is echoed in almost every book of the Bible. This week our nation has once again celebrated the long standing tradition of Thanksgiving! I, for one, am glad it does. The concept of being thankful suggests the fact that we receive so many good things from God.

If we are so certain that none should ever "bind" such an observance as a religious duty... let us be equally certain that "every man should be fully persuaded in his own mind" of the need to be THANKFUL ALWAYS, to Him who provides. There is little enough national recognition of God as it is. Good answer! Who will know?


