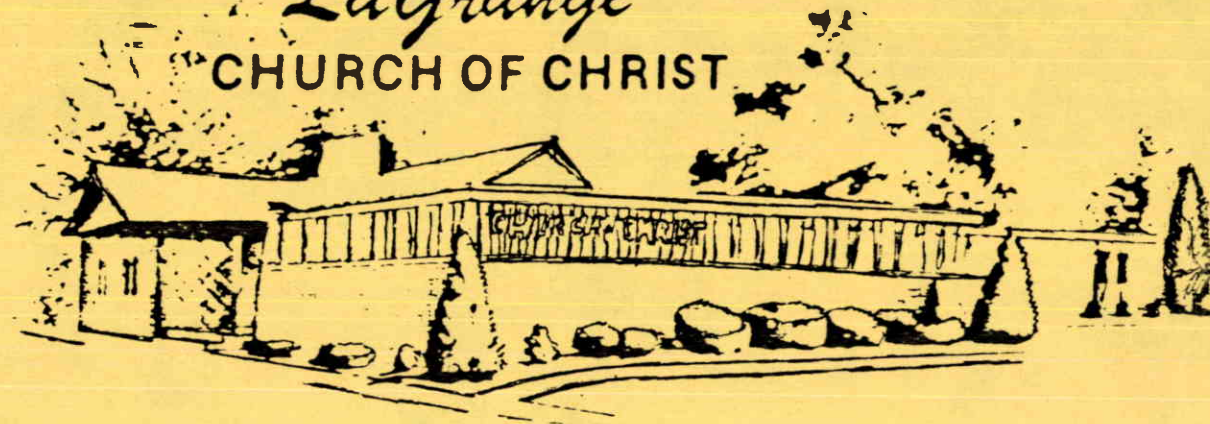

Mary Anne is an active Speaker on behalf of D.A.R. and is also involved in Community activities.

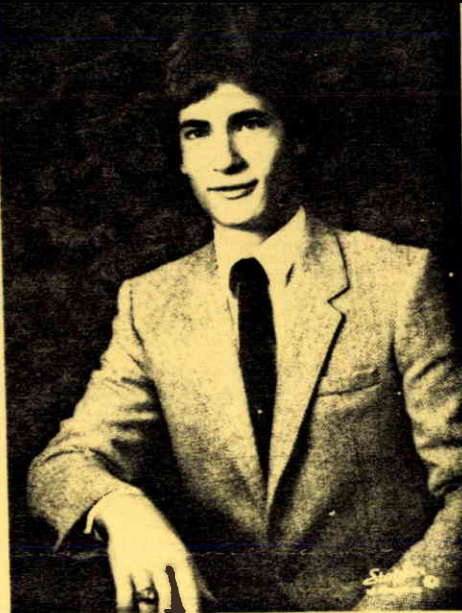
